- When you have an ‘active handicap’ you may enter specified ‘Qualifiers and Competitions’.
- Participate in the reciprocal golf arrangements with other golf clubs (1895 etc)
- Social Membership privileges giving you full access to the Clubhouse, use of the bar and dining facilities.
- Attend any social events arranged and advertised by the club.
- Obtain a ‘swipe card’ for purchasing beverages within the clubhouse at 15% discount.

\*Access to the Havers and Kirby courses is always subject to availability; details of reserved tees are given on the club website ([www.frintongolfclub.com](http://www.frintongolfclub.com)) and on the tee reservations board outside the Pro Shop. You cannot play the Havers Course before 9am Monday to Friday and before 10.45am on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays. You may only play with members’ organised groups as a guest of a full member and upon payment of the Members’ Guest Rate green fee.
