Hourly Rate Package

Frinton Golf Club also offers an option for golf societies enabling them to book the tee at an hourly rate of £450. This is of benefit to larger groups who may be able to have eight fourballs (32 golfers) tee off in an hour (if departing at seven minute intervals). The cost per golfer is only £14.06 for a round of golf. The minimum booking is for one hour, the hourly rate is pro rata if you require the tee to be booked for a longer period.

N.B. All society members must have the same menu choice.
Special dietary requirements and vegetarian options are available upon request.
All prices quoted are per person (excepting Hourly Rate bookings) and are inclusive of vat.

Society golf – visitors’ guidelines



Welcome to Frinton Golf Club – the following information will help you to enjoy your day

Upon arrival Please park in the main car park (only use the disabled spaces if appropriate); if there are no spaces, please use the overflow car park which is located to your right hand side (behind the pro shop).

After parking, the Society/Group Organiser should report to the Secretary’s Office where a member of staff will be on hand to welcome you and your group before play.

An informal introduction to your day at the Club will be given by a member of the Professional Team and/or administrative staff to appraise you of course conditions, playing formats and Club House arrangements. Please note that groups of four balls are not allowed without prior agreement with the Golf Manager, Peter Taggart.

Mobile phones Mobile phones must be switched off when on the course and in all areas of the Club House and Terrace. Mobile phones may only be used in the Locker Rooms, in the telephone kiosk or club car park.

Safety Visiting golfers must familiarise themselves with the club’s risk assessment and safety notices displayed in the Club House, paying particular attention to the public footpaths and bridleways that cross the course. Please play with safety in mind at all times as detailed in section 1 of the Rules of Golf, Etiquette, Behaviour on the Course and Safety.

Security Although security is not usually an issue at Frinton, you are advised to place your clubs out of sight, locked in your car after you have finished play or between rounds. The club will take no responsibility for lost or stolen golf equipment. Cars are parked at owner’s risk. Please do not leave valuables in the Locker Rooms.

Insurance Society members are responsible for their own insurance against 3rd party and public liability.

Accounts All accounts must be settled in full before the conclusion of your visit.

Dress code

On the golf course smart, clean, conventional golf attire should be worn. Men may wear tailored shorts with either short white socks (ankle height 'trainer' socks are not allowed) or knee length socks of a single colour; shirts must have a collar;

Ladies may wear sleeveless shirts and knee length tailored shorts with short socks or ankle socks.

No denim clothing, tracksuits or shell suits should be worn either on the courses or in the clubhouse.

Please use the changing rooms (NOT the car parks) for changing your shoes and clothing. (The code in operation can be obtained on the day of your visit from the Secretary's Office).

In the Club House clean, smart casual dress must be worn at all times. Normal golf clothing as mentioned above is allowed, as long as it is not wet or muddy.

Waterproof golf clothing and caps or hats should not be worn inside the clubhouse. Golf shoes and training shoes are not permitted in the Club House except for the changing rooms.

Frinton does not have a spike bar.



Please note that it is the responsibility of the Society Organiser to ensure that all members of the Society are aware of the Dress code operated by Frinton Golf Club. Access may be denied to any persons who are non compliant.
